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RxFill

- Message from pharmacy displaying whether Rx has been filled
 - Optional
- Message Statuses
 - **Dispensed:** Prescription has been dispensed to patient
 - **Not Dispensed:** Prescription was not dispensed to patient and medication was returned to stock
 - **Partially Dispensed:** Prescription was only partially dispensed to patient (i.e. insurance limitations)
 - **No Status:** Pharmacy has not sent RxFill status back to EHR
 - **Not Participating:** Pharmacy does not participate in RxFill

RxCancel

- Sends electronic cancellation message from prescriber to pharmacy for previously ePrescribed medication
 - Optional
 - Allows prescriber to correct mistakes if prescription sent in error, discontinue any remaining refills, or cancel active prescription if therapy should be adjusted
 - Cancellation message sent to pharmacy when the medication is stopped or marked as ineffective from the Medications Module
 - Pharmacy must participate in RxCancel

RxChange

- Message from pharmacy requesting change to original Rx
 - Optional
- Similar to eRefill request – task received in user's Inbox
 - Can configure RxChange requests to go to specific workgroup

RxChange

- Request can be Approved, Approved with Changes, or Denied
 - **Approve:** Accept suggested change request without additional modifications
 - **Approve with Changes:** Approve suggested change with modifications
 - **Deny:** Keep original prescription (must include denial reason)

RxChange

- Message Types
 - **Prior Authorization:** Prior authorization needed for patient's insurance
 - Users can only approve or deny request (cannot approve with changes)
 - User must enter valid Prior Authorization ID in order to submit approval

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


Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- New functionality to allow users to manage all medication prior authorization needs directly from within EHR
- Providers/staff can request Prior Authorization approval when medication order is created – prior to sending to pharmacy
- Request completed for one medication at a time
- Prior Authorization requirements based on PBM associated with patient
 - Formulary Eligibility Check must be run before ePA data can be obtained
 - If patient does not have formulary eligibility, ePA process will be cancelled

Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- Workflow:
 - **Create medication order**
 - Either Default Favorites or Formulary Medication Search can be used to search for medication
 - If Formulary Medication Search is used, Prior Authorization (PA) will show in the Coverage Status column

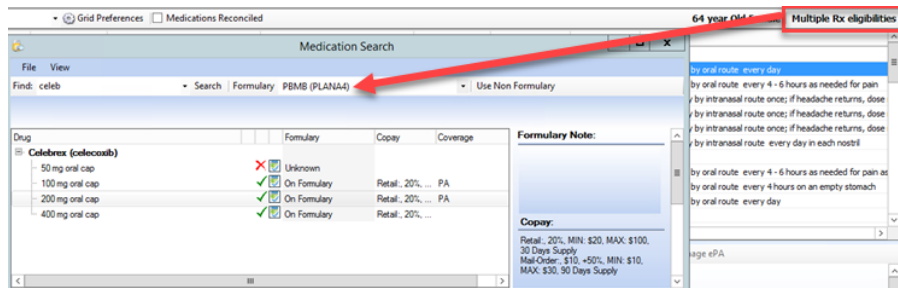

Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- Workflow:

- **Create medication order**

- If patient is eligible for more than one formulary, user can set desired formulary in Formulary Medication Search
 - User may be prompted to choose PBM when request initiated



Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- **Click Initiate ePA link**

- User clicks Initiate ePA link in Medications Module
 - Medication is locked for edit until PBM responds with next step
 - Patients must have formulary eligibility before an ePA can be initiated
 - If patient has multiple eligibilities, a Choose PBM popup may appear

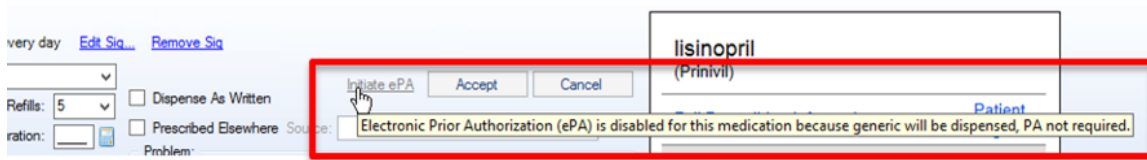

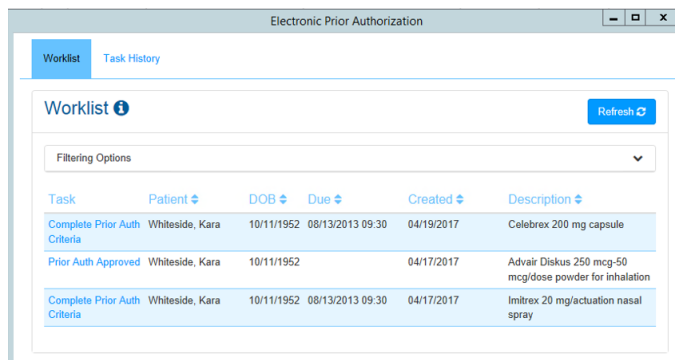

 - Hovering over link will display tooltip that explains why disabled
 - i.e. Can't be initiated because Practice Preferences are set to "Always Send Generic if not DAW"

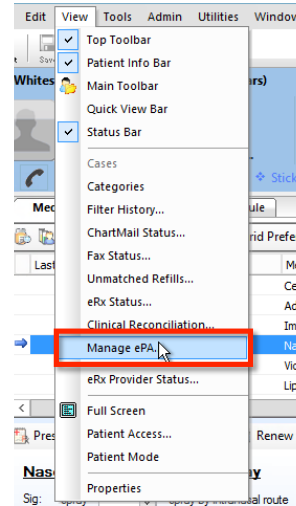
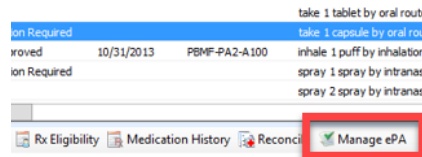

- Allows user to communicate with PBM for any medications requiring prior authorization

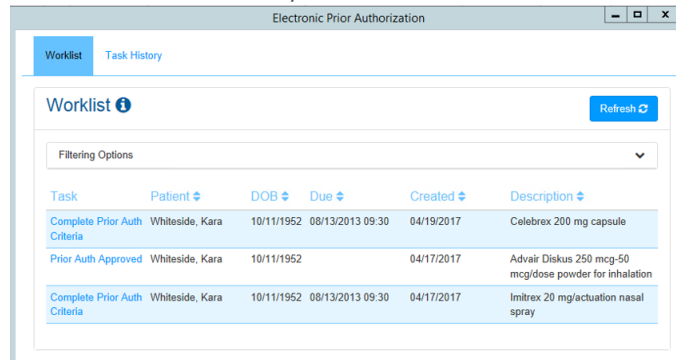

 - **Patient Mode** – Requests managed for current patient only
 - View Menu > Manage ePA
 - **Provider Mode** – Requests managed for all patients for Current Provider



Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- **Complete and Submit Question Set**

- PBM responds to request with Question Set, typically within seconds
- All information necessary to obtain authorization in Question Set

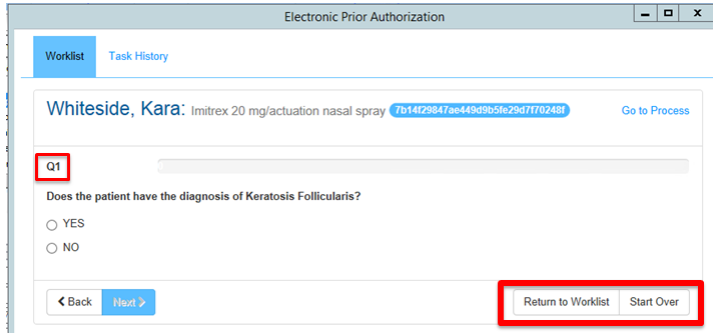

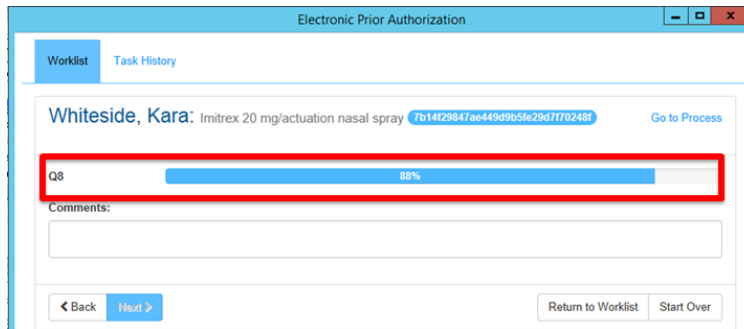

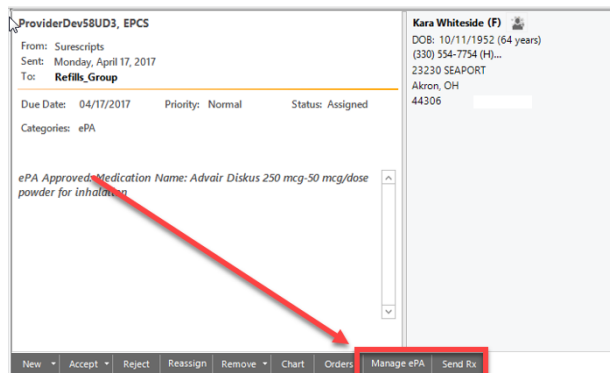
Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- **View ePA Status**

- Statuses:
 - **PA Required** – Shows if particular medication requires authorization
 - Warning appears if user attempts to Send Rx without completing ePA
 - **In Progress** – Shows if authorization process has been initiated for medication
 - Warning appears if user attempts to send the prescription
 - **Action Required** – Shows if further action is needed to approve authorization
 - **Approved/Denied** – Authorization approval/denial has been received for medication
 - Approved requests can be sent to pharmacy via eRx, Fax, or Print
 - Includes all Prior Authorization Details when prescription sent
 - Denied Requests can be sent, but patient may pay more for medication
 - **Closed/Cancelled** – Shows if authorization request was cancelled by user
 - **Error** – Shows if there is a system error with the authorization

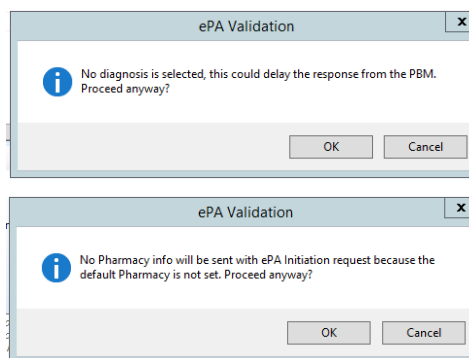
Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- **ePA Integration with Tasking**
 - Users can perform actions associated with ePA directly from tasks (similar to eRefill task)
 - ePA specific workgroup designated for these requests
 - Accept task first, reassign if needed
 - From task, user can click Manage ePA button – launches Manage ePA window to Worklist tab
 - Complete Question Set as normal
 - After ePA approved, user can Send Rx from task (eRx only)
 - Task Auto-Completes when Manage ePA or Send Rx is complete (also auto-completes if completed in Med Module or View Menu)



Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- **Best Practices**
 - Add Diagnosis to Medication
 - Used as indication for medication
 - Speeds up ePA process as PBM typically requests this
 - Warning displays if no diagnosis selected
 - Add Default Pharmacy
 - Warning will display if no pharmacy selected

 - PBM will need complete prescription details: SIG, Quantity

Electronic Prior Authorization (ePA)

- Additional Details

- Exclusion List Exceptions
 - ePA cannot be run for any patient that is on any user's exclusion list
 - Manage ePA window cannot filter restricted patients
 - Existing Prior Authorization process would need to be used
 - ePA cannot be run through the View Menu (Provider Mode) by any user with a patient in his/her exclusion list
 - User can still initiate and manage the ePA for individual patient through Medications Module
- ePA Case # and Prior Authorization Status displays on the RxPrint and RxFax documents

Prescription Drug Monitoring Report (PDMP)

- Users can now view PDMP reports directly from the EHR
 - Many states now mandate prescribers to view PDMP report prior to prescribing controlled substances
 - This functionality qualifies towards one of the Clinical Performance Improvement Activities (CPIA) under the Merit-Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS)
 - PDMP Reports have been integrated into NextGen EHR to serve as alternative to accessing through third party
 - NextGen has partnered with Appriss Gateway for this integration
 - PDMP Reports provide real-time data (updated every 24 hours)
 - Shows detailed list of selected patient's controlled substance history from all pharmacies in the state
 - Multiple state configuration is allowed per individual state guidelines
 - Practices can make it required to view report prior to prescribing controlled substances

Prescription Drug Monitoring Report (PDMP)

- Appriss Gateway
 - Each practice will contract directly with Appriss Health
 - Small annual fee per provider may apply
 - Some states may offer assistance with this fee
 - To find out if your state participates, receive additional information, and/or sign up with Appriss, complete the Appriss EHR Integration Sign-Up form

 - If you would like this functionality, please begin this process now
 - After signing up with Appriss Gateway, a unique PDMP User Name and Password will be given



Prescription Drug Monitoring Report (PDMP)

- Access
 - Medications Module
 - Report can be generated manually or automatically
 - **Automatic** – Runs report upon opening Medication Module or on encounter creation (just like eligibility checks)
 - Does not automatically launch report, but queues it up for faster loading of report

- Workflow
 - Medications Module
 - When ready to prescribe medication, click PDMP button from Medication Module to review report details
 - NOTE: User must have permissions to run/view report
