Requirement



Why?

Patient generated health data or data from a non-clinical setting is incorporated into the CEHRT for more than 5 percent of all unique patients seen by the EP or discharged from the eligible hospital or CAH inpatient or emergency department during the reporting period. The new criteria for 2015 requires the CEHRT to demonstrate how a user has the ability to link to an external internet site where the health information document is stored



Medicare QPP and Medicaid Meaningful Use Stage 3 Certification Requirements

- The ability for a user to enter a website URL link where patient health information is stored
- The ability to annotate information about health information stored externally
- The ability to click a link to launch the website
- The ability to audit events for enter, view, modify, and delete

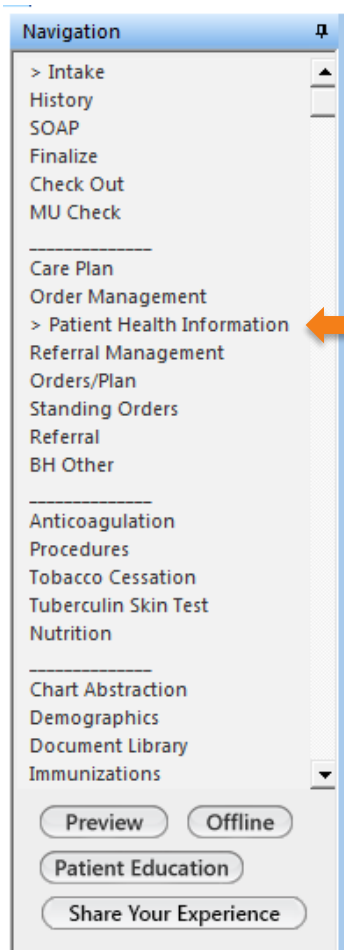
